How We Collect

DynamicsPact is the data controller of personal data collected via our website www.dynamics-pact.com or by engaging with us digitally, by telephone, email, in person or via social media and marketing activities. This includes information you provide to us when you;

- Visit/browse our website
- Online Live Chats
- Complete forms on our website, landing pages.
- Subscribe to our services.
- Attend our event.
- Participate in discussion on our boards and social media.
- Enter competitions, promotion and satisfaction surveys.
- Purchase our products and services.

How We Use Your Personal Data

The processing of your personal data will in some cases be necessary to comply with requests from you. In addition, the processing of your personal data may be based on our legitimate interest in the following areas;

- Conducting marketing activities
- To develop and evaluate our products and services
- Conducting statistics & analytics

DynamicsPact will only use your personal data in order to send you product information, newsletters and other marketing material via e-mail if you have requested it and provided us with your prior and explicit consent, unless applicable legislation allows us to contact you without such consent.

DynamicsPact keeps statistics of which areas of the website are visited by our users. This data does not include personal data. Using the collected data, DynamicsPact builds knowledge of the use of the website. This information is used to improve the website. However, we use data on the navigation of all our users to be able to understand how our users as a total group use the website and against this background we attempt to improve the website users experience. We cannot see where you come from or go to on the Internet when you leave our website.

Cookies

DynamicsPact declares that our website www.dynamics-pact.com utilises cookies. When using our web site, the user agrees for the implementation of cookies on his or her device.

Cookie are used to:

- Adjust the content of web sites to user preferences and the optimisation of web site use, these files allow, in particular, to recognise the device of the web user and display the site in a correct way, adapted to individual needs.

- Creating statistic charts, which help understand how the users of the web site utilise the service, which enables the improvement of its structure and content,
- Providing users with commercial material, better adapted to their interests.

Types of cookie used by DynamicsPact are as follows

- “necessary” cookies, for access to services available on the web service, e.g. enabling the use of sessions.
- “functional” cookie files enabling, remembering the settings chosen by the user and the personalisation of the user interface e.g. in the scope of the chosen mobile/desktop version, the last phrases entered by the user, the appearance of the web site, etc.
- “analytical” cookies, enabling the monitoring of user activity on the web site.

The user can block the option of saving cookie files by changing the setting of the Internet browser. The user can also clear past cookies by accessing the history setting of the internet browser. Turning off the cookies can affect the functioning of the website. Not changing the settings of the browsers means consent to the cookies used.

Security
