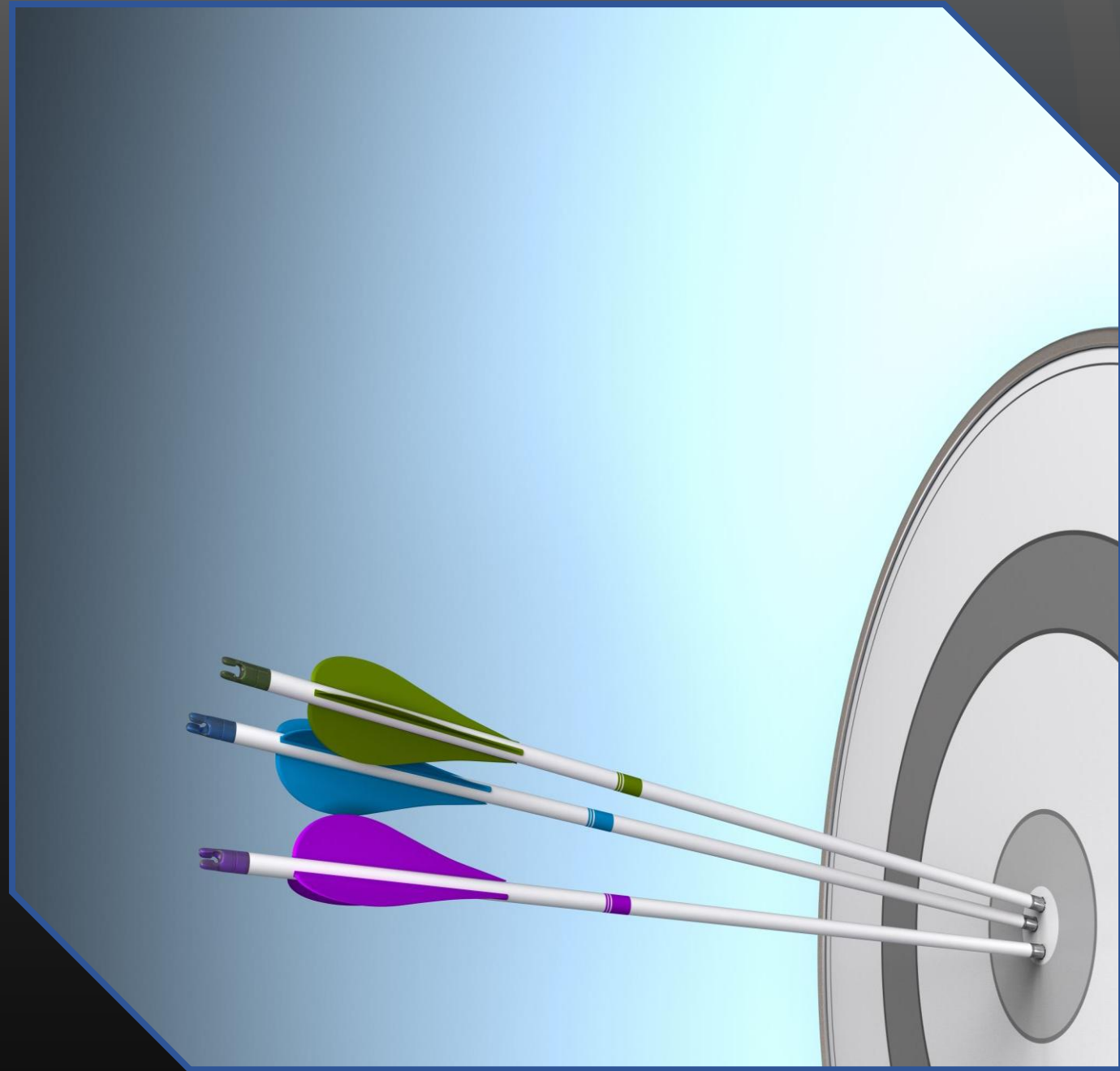

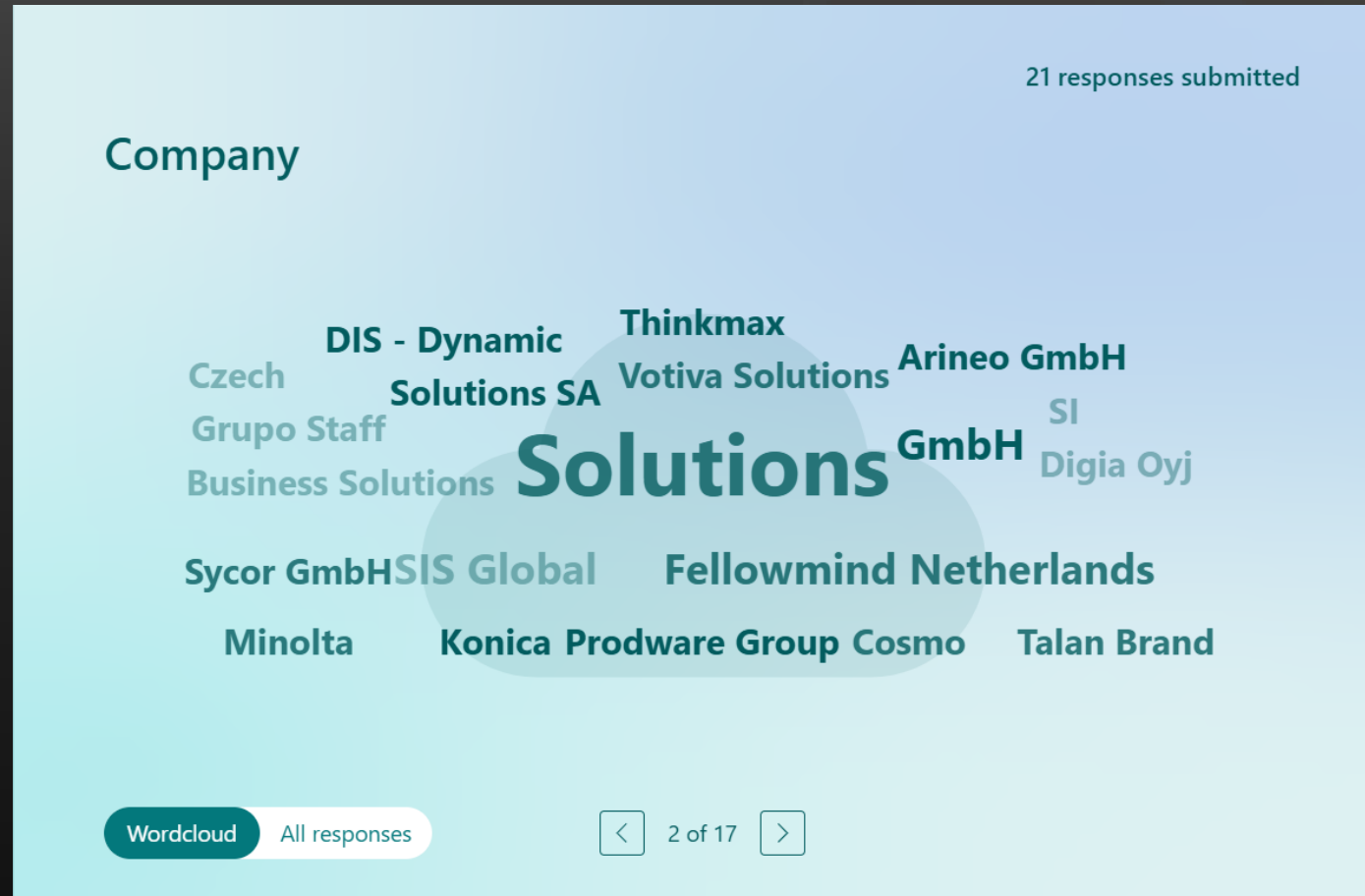

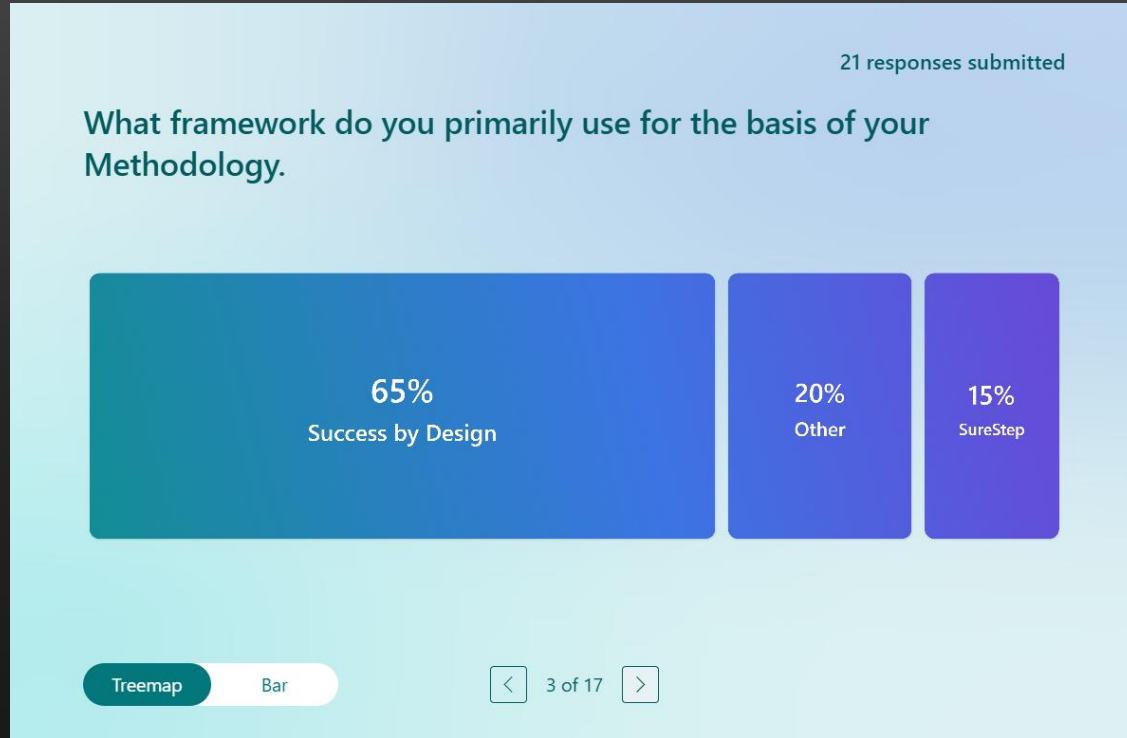

Responses from 21/28 Members



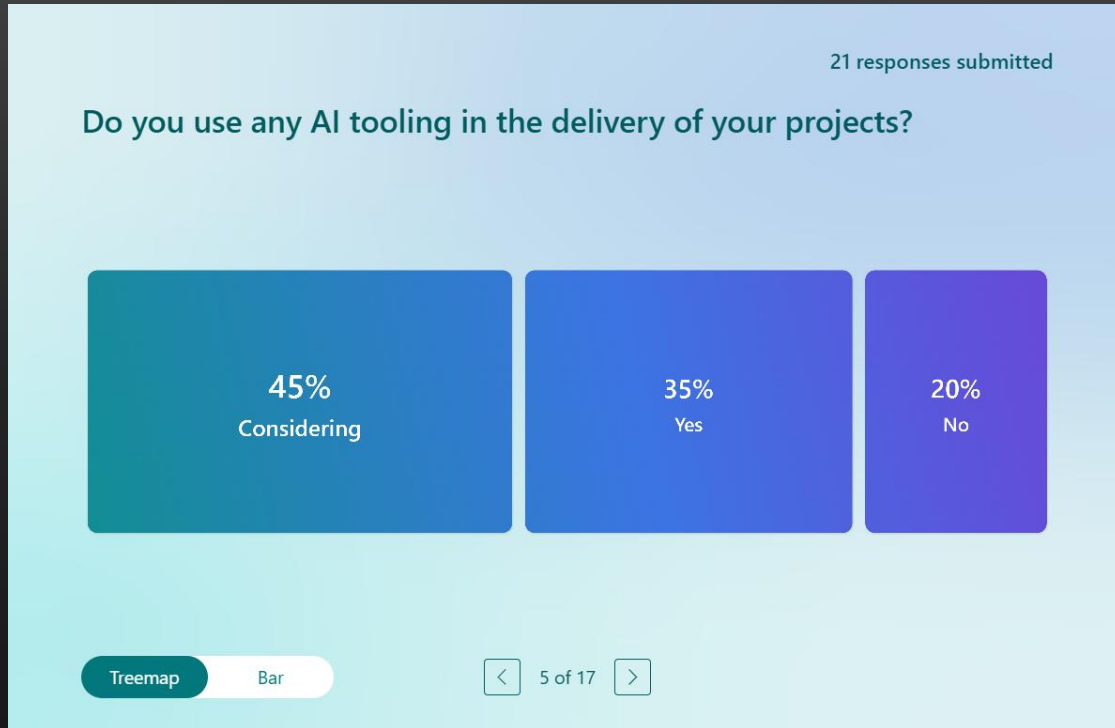
What framework do you primarily use for the basis of your Methodology.

- Our implementation methodology is called SureValue which is a mix of SureStep and Success by Design."

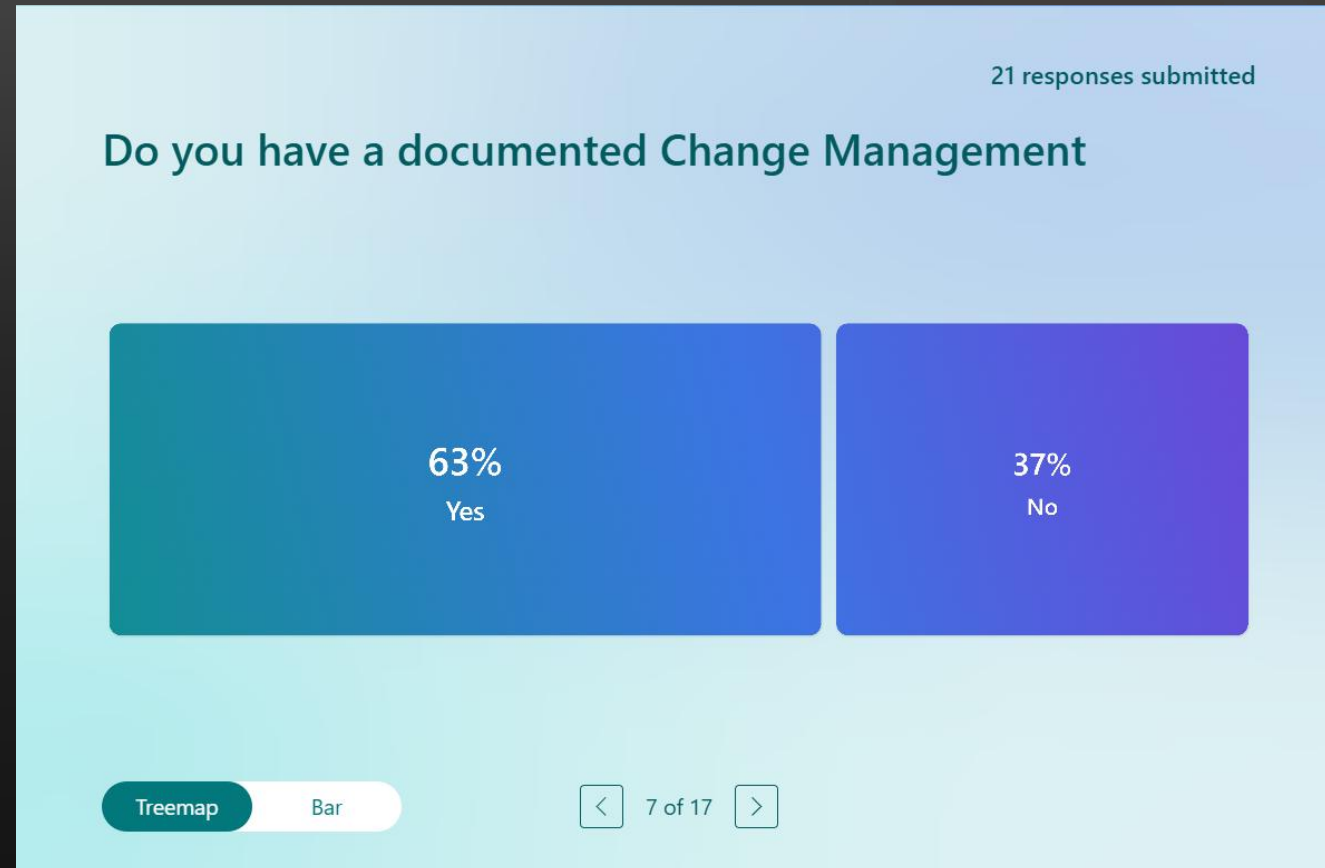

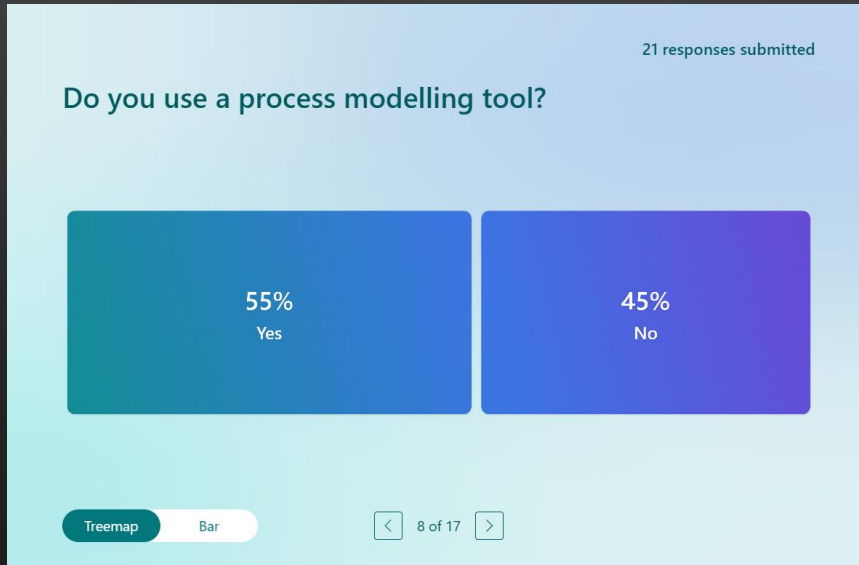

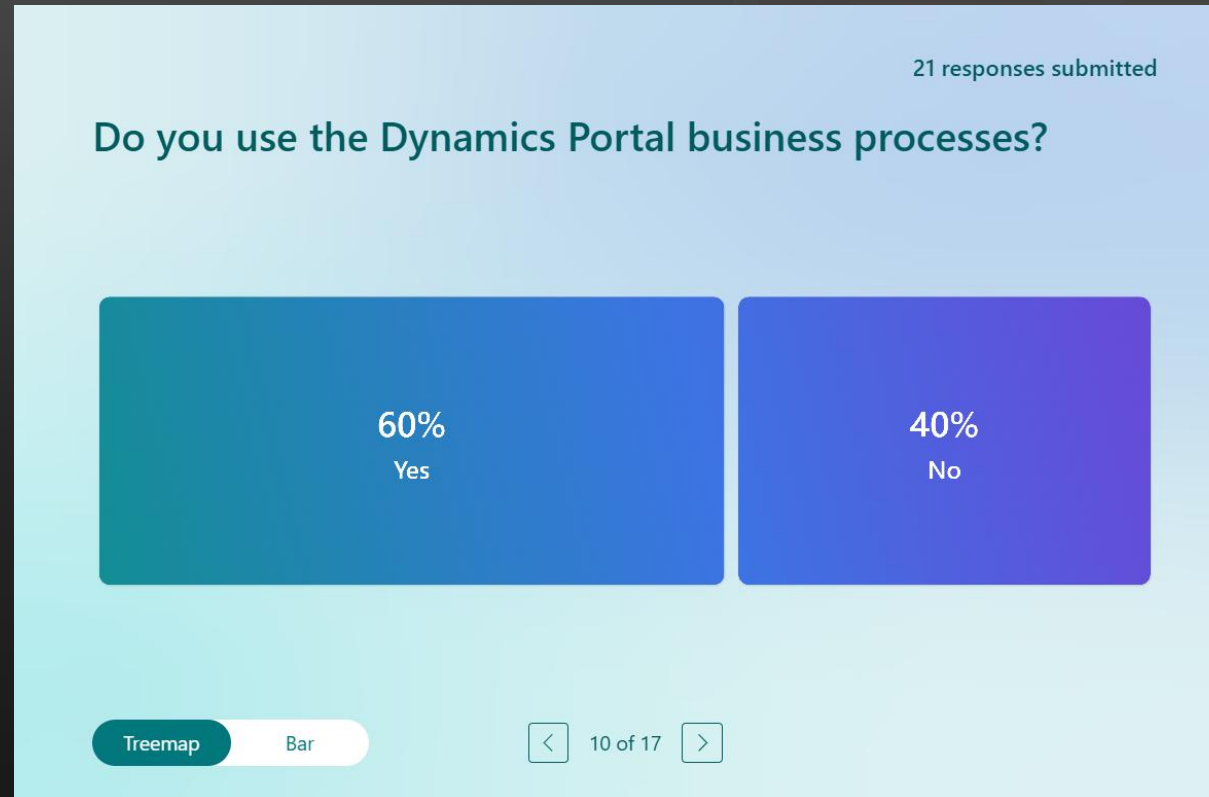

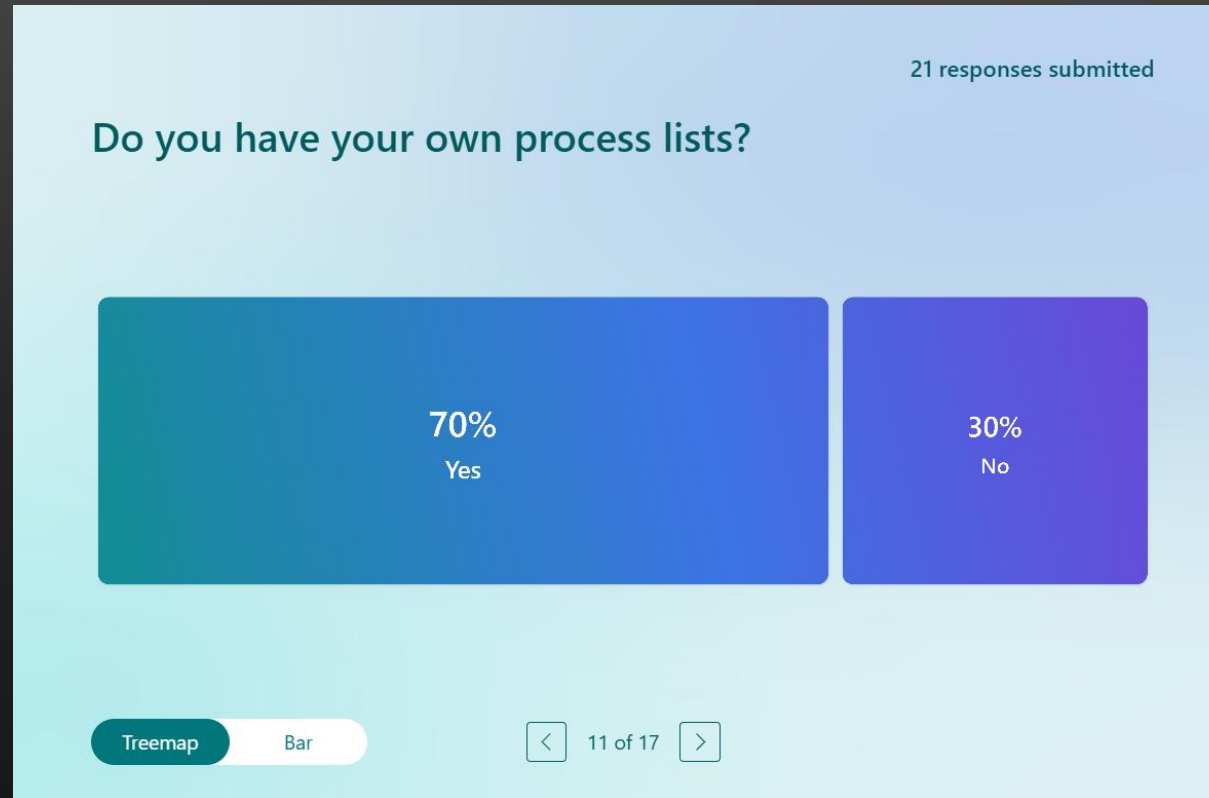
Tools Used

- Microsoft Visio
- We have some CM consultants and they have documented CM discipline. I have not had any dealings with CM in my projects so far. Our business consultants use Visio
- We use the MS Business Process Catalog. Visualisation is created with Miro Board.
- We are just introducing the process modelling tool Camunda. It is free and compatible with other process tools (import/export of BPMN format). If with Change Management, change request handling to mitigate scope creeping is meant, we do have a documented discipline. If with Change Management, the discipline of guiding employees through change is meant, we do not have that documented.
- We used the BPM tool of LCS and now working on moving to the new tool from MS for business process by industry. Not done yet and still learning.
- We just started process catalog for some of the scopes
- Visio BUT a very at a very low level. challenge is that customers coming from a legacy solution can only use such tools once they are in the cloud and live.
- We would like to use Business process catalogue, but mostly we use customer process documentation and DevOps backlog. No special tool
- We use MAVIM as process modelling tool and have our own process library.
